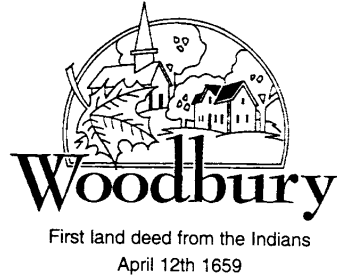

Budget Matters

The Board discussed the FY 2010-11 Budget.

The figures approved are all net salaries (if applicable).

130-Land Use – Reduced with the deletion of training.

MOTION: Selectman Hale moved and Selectman Perkinson seconded the approval of Account 130-Land Use at \$75,300 and refer it to the Board of Finance.
UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED

920-Misc.

MOTION: Selectman Hale moved and Selectman Perkinson seconded the approval of Account 920-Misc. at \$154,103 and refer it to the Board of Finance.
UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED

330-Parks & Lawn Maintenance – Reduced as a result of outside contractor bid.

MOTION: Selectman Perkinson moved and Selectman Hale second the approval of Account 330-Parks & Lawn Maintenance at \$56,500 and refer it to the Board of Finance.

940-Capital Appropriations

MOTION: Selectman Perkinson moved and Selectman Hale seconded the approval of Account 940-Capital Appropriations at \$748,258 and refer it to the Board of Finance. *UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED*

Pay Plan – 5.26%% increase over last year.

MOTION: Selectman Perkinson moved and Selectman Hale seconded the approval of the Pay Plan at \$3,162,872. *UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED*

MOTION: Selectman Perkinson moved and Selectman Hale seconded to approve the FY 2010-11 budget, including Pay Plan, at \$9,205,628. *UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED*

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:20 p.m.
